

## PORTSMOUTH CAMPUS

The new Fred W. Beazley Portsmouth Campus opened for classes in spring 2010 and is located in the Victory Village area of Portsmouth on 35 acres near Interstate 264 and Victory Boulevard. Totalling 183,000 square feet, four buildings house academic programs, administrative offices, student services, and a physical plant. In 2013-14, a new student center opened on the campus. The new Portsmouth Campus replaces TCC's founding campus, which opened in 1968 when the Beazley Foundation donated the former Frederick College in northern Suffolk and \$1 million to the Commonwealth of Virginia to establish a community college to serve South Hampton Roads.
