The Administrative Association's 2013-14 End of Year Report to the President's Advisory and Planning Council provides an overview of activities and accomplishments during the 2013-14 academic year.

The actions listed below were taken by the Administrative Association in 2013-14.

- 1. Promoted activities that develops the skills, productivity, and professionalism of the Administrative Association's members and of the college;
- 2. Continued to represent the needs, concerns, and viewpoints of administrators and professional employees; and
- 3. Provided a forum in which meaningful discussion may take place on issues that affect administrators, professional employees, and the entire TCC community.
