 - 2207 Domicile and In-State Tuition Determinations and Appeals (College Registrar feedback needed)
 - o 2208 Admissions (Admissions/Enrollment Services feedback needed)
 - o 2210 Student Complaint Process
- It was decided that the next 2 meetings will focus on completing the following charges for the committee:

- Create and present a process allowing for student feedback specific to the implementation of the advising model
- Develop and present a college-wide model for engaging students in career services and employer hiring and networking events.
- The following policies remain to be edited:

 - 2212 Student Development Course (SDV)
 - 2213 Advising
