Campus Specific

- O Portsmouth: Portsmouth has still not yet appointed a pro temp or replaced VP. Portsmouth provost has agreed to semesterly forum. College President has declined an annual forum for the time being. Portsmouth created a survey to evaluate need for personal counselor for each campus. Had public outburst from disturbed student who was affiliated with SGA on Wednesday the 28th, the day before #IChooseLoveCampaign launched on Portsmouth campus. Food Survey committee created survey, planning to send out to all students through email. Director of Student Center has been acting as interim advisor. Secretary has gone AWOL. Treasurer is pulling double duty as Secretary. Held Student Leaders Organization Training on same day as Fed meeting. Assembling binder of advice, suggestions and bylaws to leave to next administration. Has yet to create or adopt bylaws.
- Norfolk: Has recruited fifteen new senators and rechartered or chartered twenty clubs. Having personal conduct issues with a Norfolk Senator previously kicked out of Chesapeake senate for disruptive behavior. Orchestra Club was suspended for not rechartering for a year, recruiting members at high schools without TCC's permission, putting club funds in a personal account instead of a club account. Has float in Grand Illumination Parade. Has adapted VB'S bylaws to own campus.
- Chesapeake: Appointed new Secretary after former Secretary left school, have nineteen active senators. Formed three new committees: Events, Student Sentiment and Judiciary Committee. Planning to form Fundraising Committee.

- Hosting Masquerade Ball with Haunted House on October 27th. Planning "Second Chance Prom" and will start raising funds in November. Gathering three-hundred signatures to petition the Provost. Has adapted VB'S bylaws to own campus.
- Virginia Beach: Actively recruiting and rebuilding senate. Planning Foreign Events Committee. Held Health Fair and "Spring Break, Spring Broke" event to warn against dangers of drunk driving. Diversity and Inclusion Presentation headed by Susan James. Mariah attended Retention Task Force meeting. She suggested that it was because students found VB campus "boring." Dean Marilyn Hodge agreed. Phi Theta Kappa and Virginia21 hosted Candidate Forum for Council and Mayoral race. Several VB Student Leaders were in attendance. Holding a US VP Debate viewing party.
